

NOTICE

This Notice is to inform you that the Cheyenne Housing Authority Board of Commissioners has opened the Public Comment Period for acceptance of comments on one proposed revision to the Animals that Assist the Disabled Policy.

Current Policy:

All assistance animals must be inoculated against rabies, distemper, and other such diseases and conditions as required by local, city, county, state, or federal law. If assistance animals are not inoculated as required by law, then in order to protect the health and safety of the tenant, the household, guests, other residents, and Authority staff, the assistance animal will not be allowed to reside or be used at Authority property until such time as the inoculation is completed. The Tenant whose reasonable accommodation of an assistance animal was approved is required to furnish documentation of the animal's current inoculation status if requested by Authority

Proposed Policy Revision:

It is the tenant / animal's owner responsibility to have the assistance or service animal inoculated against rabies, distemper, and other such diseases and conditions as required by local, city, county, state, or federal law.

Reason for proposed change:

The CHA has adjusted it's policy to comply with the Fair Housing mandate.
